An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Needham as the Lt. Joseph R. Fandrey Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The Highland Ave. bridge number N-04-002 located in the town of Needham shall be  
2 designated and known as The Lt. Joseph R. Fandrey Memorial Bridge in honor and recognition  
3 of Joseph Fandrey who served as a Helicopter Pilot in the United States Marine Corps. Joseph  
4 lost his life on May 10, 1996, during a training exercise in Camp Lejune, N.C. The  
5 Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing  
6 the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
