**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to insurance points surcharges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, at the end thereof the following sentence:-

3 In fixing and establishing classifications of risk, the commissioner of insurance shall not
4 promulgate any rules or regulations to add surcharge points to a motor vehicle insurance
5 premium, based on at-fault accidents or convictions of moving violations of motor vehicle laws,
6 for damages not exceeding \$1,000.
