The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to association health plans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all multiple
- 2 employer welfare arrangements, as defined in chapter 176J of the general laws, which includes
- 3 association health plans, shall be subject to the commonwealth's minimum credible coverage
- 4 standards and department of insurance review and approval requirements.
- 5 The commissioner, as defined in said chapter 176J, shall promulgate all regulations
- 6 necessary to implement this section.
