An Act relative to the definition of consistent with local needs in chapter 40b.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The second sentence of the definition of “Consistent with local needs” in section 20 of  
2 chapter 40B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out clause (1) and inserting in place thereof the following clause:- (1) low or  
4 moderate income housing exists which is: (i) in excess of 10 per cent of the housing units  
5 reported in the latest federal decennial census of a city or town with a housing inventory of 5,000  
6 units or more; (ii) in excess of 5 per cent of the housing units reported in the latest federal  
7 decennial census of a city or town with less than 5,000 housing units; or (iii) on sites comprising  
8 one and one half per cent or more of the total land area zoned for residential, commercial or  
9 industrial use, or.
