An Act relative to smart growth housing production.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 40R of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the figure “40A,” in line 9, the following:-  
3 ; provided, however, that a smart growth zoning district or starter home zoning district ordinance  
4 or by-law shall be adopted, amended or repealed by a simple majority vote of all the members of  
5 the town council, or of the city council where there is a commission form of government or a  
6 single branch, or of each branch where there are 2 branches, or by a simple majority vote of a  
7 town meeting.”.
