### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to public housing restrictions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 32 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- Notwithstanding any
- 3 general or special law or regulation to the contrary, an applicant for assisted housing under this
- 4 chapter who is not eligible for federal assisted housing under 42 U.S.C. section 1436a shall not
- 5 displace or be given priority over any applicant who is so eligible.
