**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the reporting of drug overdose deaths.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12A of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 4 by inserting after the word “firearm,” the following
3 words:- "or having examined or treated a person suspected of dying from injuries resulting from
4 opiate, illegal or illicit drug overdose,".
