Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5-305 of Chapter 190B of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the word "person." in line 3, the
- 3 following:-
- 4 The reasonable expenses of such appointed guardian, including compensation and
- 5 counsel fees, shall be determined by the court and paid as it may order, either out of the estate or
- 6 by the plaintiff, petitioner or the commonwealth.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 5-308 of said Chapter 190B of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 8 the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the word "periods." in line 24, the
- 9 follow:-

- The reasonable expenses of such temporary guardian, including compensation and
- 11 counsel fees, shall be determined by the court and paid as it may order, either out of the estate or
- by the plaintiff, petitioner or the commonwealth, for each 90 day period.
