Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:-
- Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the division
- 4 shall develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care attendant
- 5 program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible for said
- 6 program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more activities of
- 7 daily living.
