*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby amended by deleting in the first sentence the words:-  
2 or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness.

3           Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby further amended by deleting in the first sentence the  
4 words:- or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness to the department of  
5 mental health.
