An Act relative to activating the health care proxy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1

2           Section 6 of Chapter 201D as appearing in the 2016 General Laws is hereby amended by  
3 adding the following subsection:

4           (b) “In determining whether a patient is competent for the purposes of activating their  
5 health care proxy, a physician shall evaluate the patient’s competency for their treatment.”

6           Section 2

7           The Department of Public Health shall promulgate regulations pursuant to subsection b.
