An Act relative to statewide grand juries.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make statewide grand juries a permanent system for the Attorney General's Office, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Sections 46 and 77 of chapter 10 of the acts of 2015 are hereby repealed
