**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to establishing a prevailing wage for security officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 2 Section 27H of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
2 amended by striking, in lines 1 and 2, the words "the cleaning and maintenance of" and inserting
3 in place thereof the following words:- "cleaning, maintenance or security guard services in", and
4 inserting, after the word "maintenance", on line 6, the following words: " , security guard".
