**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act An act relative to the term of special permits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
2 by section 16 of chapter 209 of the acts of 2018, is hereby amended by striking out the fourteen  
3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following new paragraph:—

4 Zoning ordinances or by-laws shall provide that a special permit granted under this  
5 section shall lapse within a specified period of time, not less than 3 years from the date of filing  
6 of such approval with the city or town clerk, which shall not include such time required to pursue  
7 or await the determination of an appeal referred to in section seventeen, from the grant thereof, if  
8 a substantial use thereof has not sooner commenced except for good cause, or in the cause of a  
9 permit for construction, if construction has not begun by such date except for good cause.
