Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The definition "Health care provider" in section 1 of Chapter 111 of the

2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words "registered nurse," the following

3 words "registered pharmacist."
