The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to sheet metal work.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 237 of chapter 112 of General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "professions", in line 45, the
3	following words:-; provided further, that sheet metal work relative to privately bid jobs shall not
4	include the installation, assembly, or integration of any water tight, pre-engineered or
5	prefabricated metal building systems, including structural members, roof systems, standing seam
6	roofs, rib roofs or sidewall systems, on or into a pre-engineered metal building structure in
7	accordance with manufacturer specifications.
8	SECTION 2. The board of examiners of sheet metal workers shall adopt rules and
9	regulations relative to the practice of sheet metal work in accordance with this act on or before

10 January 1, 2020.
