An Act to update postural screenings in schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 57 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended, by striking out, in line 21, the words “annually in grades  
3   five through nine” and inserting in place thereof the following words :- “in grades 6, 7, 8, or 9.”
