In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act protecting youth from second hand smoke.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 127A of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph: -
3	Smoking shall be prohibited in all enclosed areas of a multi-unit residence, including
4	inside the residential units of the building, for which the municipal authorization of occupancy
5	for any part of the building occurs on or after January 1, 2020. "Multi-unit Residence" means
6	property containing two (2) or more Units, including, but not limited to, apartment buildings,
7	condominium complexes, senior and assisted living facilities, and long-term health care
8	facilities, but does not include a single-family home physically detached from another residential

9 or commercial structure, except if and when used as a healthcare or childcare services subject to

- 10 municipal or state licensing requirements. "Smoking" means the lighting or possessing of a
- 11 lighted of a cigar, cigarette, pipe or other tobacco product or non-tobacco product including

- designed to be combusted and inhaled, including marijuana. Smoking shall not mean the heatingof marijuana that does not cause combustion.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 127C of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 15 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the words "tenant" wherever it appears, and
- 16 inserting in place thereof "tenant or condominium unit owner."
