Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 Section 13 of chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the word
- 3 "17" and replacing it with the word "20" and by striking subsection (c)(2) of section 12 of
- 4 chapter 13 and replacing it with the following section:-
- 5 (2) five registered nurses in advanced practice, representing each clinical category of
- 6 advanced practice, each of whom must meet requirements for authorization as a registered nurse
- 7 in advanced practice as established by the board, at least three of whom is employed providing
- 8 direct patient care at the time of appointment;
