Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 131P of Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the word "curriculum" the following words:- Said curriculum must include a
- 3 minimum of at least 5 hours of live discharge of firearms, rifles, and shotguns at a license gun
- 4 club, including the discharge of at least 50 rounds of ammunition.
