**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to Boston school police retirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 ORDERED: That a petition to the General Court, accompanied by a bill for a special
2 law relating to the City of Boston to be filed with an attested copy of this Order be, and hereby
3 is, approved under Clause One (1) of Section Eight (8) of Article Two (2), as amended, of the
4 Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to the end that
5 legislation be adopted precisely as follows, except for clerical or editorial changes of form only:

6 PETITION FOR A SPECIAL LAW RE: AN ACT CONCERNING THE RETIREMENT
7 CLASSIFICATION FOR BOSTON SCHOOL POLICE OFFICERS.

8 SECTION 1. Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 3 of chapter 32 of the
9 General Laws, as amended by chapter 221 of the acts of 2018, is hereby amended by inserting
10 after the words “services having police powers;” the following words:- Boston school police
11 officers;.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
