An Act to increase membership in the PRIM board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (2A) of section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2      appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 186, the word  
3      "nine" and inserting in place thereof the word "eleven".

4           SECTION 2. Subsection (2A) of section 23 of chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby  
5      amended by inserting after the word "governor", in line 202 the following words:-

6           ", and two elected by members of the Executive Board of the Massachusetts Association  
7      of Contributory Retirement Systems: from systems that have funds in the PRIT Fund; one from a  
8      regional or county board, and one from a municipal retirement board."
