Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 91 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016

Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after sub-section (e) the following sub-sections:-

- 4 (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (d), inclusive, any individual who
- 5 retires from Group IV, who had been employed as either a municipal police officer or firefighter,
- 6 of any rank, may provide consulting services to one or more municipalities, either individually as
- 7 a sole proprietor or retained by a corporation or other business entity, for such period of time and
- 8 for such mutually agreed upon compensation as the municipality deems necessary and
- 9 appropriate provided such contractual relationship does not involve a conflict of interest in
- violation of Chapter 268A of the General Laws.
- 11 (g) The restrictions against post-retirement earnings contained in this section shall not
- 12 apply to a retired member of Group IV that subsequently is selected to serve as either the

- 13 Secretary of Public Safety and Security, the Undersecretary of Public Safety and Security, or is
- employed in any capacity for the Municipal Police Training Committee or the Department of
- 15 Fire Services Academy.
