An Act providing for equitable retirement benefits for public higher education police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 subsection (g) of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following after the words  
3 “University of Massachusetts police” campus police officers employed at state colleges,  
4 universities and community colleges
