**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act exempting Ryan M. Charette from the maximum age requirement for appointment as a firefighter in the town of Dracut.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law to the contrary, Ryan M. Charette, shall be eligible to have his name certified for
3 original appointment to the position of firefighter for Town of Dracut, notwithstanding having
4 reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service examination in connection with that
5 appointment.

6 SECTION 2. Ryan M. Charette, shall be eligible for appointment to the position of
7 firefighter in the Town of Dracut, if he otherwise qualifies and is selected for employment under
8 chapter 31 of the General Laws, regulations of the civil service commission and any lawful
9 hiring practices for the Town of Dracut.
