An Act relative to alcoholic beverage containers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the Massachusetts General Laws (2016  
2 Official Edition) is hereby amended by adding after the words “thirty-three” in line 143, the  
3 following:

4           "Any such licensee shall be permitted to make sales in any size container approved by the  
5 Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) as appearing in Title 27 CFR 5.47 a(a)(1)."
