**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to Executive Office of Public Safety and Security dispatchers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "supervision of prisoners;", in  
3 line 272, the following: - "employees of the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security  
4 working as State Police Dispatchers or State 911 Dispatchers in groups SPD 1, 2, and 3 who  
5 have been employed in a such a capacity for 10 years or more;"
