An Act relative to ensure fairness for certain employees of the department of corrections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 326, after the words “assistant deputy  
3 superintendent” the following words:- correctional program officer A/B, C, D, or equivalent or  
4 successive titles who have been employed in such capacities or other Group 4 titles for 10 years  
5 or more
