An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Brian S. Bibeau, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the office of the Department  
2 of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Brian S. Bibeau, an employee of the  
3 Department of Correction. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Brian S. Bibeau.  
5 Whenever Brian S. Bibeau terminates employment within the department or requests to dissolve  
6 the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
9 the department.
