An Act repealing the sales tax on boats built or rebuilt in the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:—
- 3 (yy) Sales of boats built or rebuilt and delivered in Massachusetts by Massachusetts
- 4 craftsmen.
