## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to bundled cellular telephone transactions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following new section:
- 3 (x) Allowances afforded to a purchaser in a bundled cellular telephone
- 4 transaction, so-called. For the purposes of this subsection, allowances exempt from taxation
- 5 shall be the difference between the amount the dealer charges for a particular telephone in a
- 6 bundled transaction and the price the dealer would charge for that same telephone in an
- 7 unbundled transaction.
