**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act clarifying the limited exemption from taxation of certain facilities for the treatment of committed mentally ill patients.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause third (c) of section five of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended in line 3 by inserting after the word "disorders" the following: - "of persons
3 committed to a facility pursuant to chapter one hundred and twenty-three,".
