An Act relative to the motor vehicle excise tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1 of chapter 60a of the General Laws is hereby amended in line 17 by inserting  
2 after “10%” the following:

3           “After ten years, vehicles and trailers with an evaluation of less than \$2000 will no longer  
4 be subject to the excise established by this section.”
