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An Act requiring municipalities to place insurance out to bid.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 30B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 36, the words "insurance or".
