Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 29 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016 official edition is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after section 71 the following section:-
- 3 Section 72. State funds shall not be used to purchase bottled water for use in facilities that
- 4 are served by public water supplies or potable well water, except when required for safety, health
- 5 or emergency situations.
