An Act relative to cybersecurity standards in government procurements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 30B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 official edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following section:-

3 “Section 24. (a) All contracts, subcontracts, or procurements made by the Commonwealth  
4 or any of its quasi government agencies or independent agencies involving a technological  
5 component shall comply with regulations of the Commerce Control List (CCL) as established by  
6 the Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) at the United States Department of Commerce.

7 (b) This section shall only apply to contracts, subcontracts, or procurements of over  
8 \$1,000,000.”
