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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court**  
**(2019-2020)**  
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An Act relative to the MBTA Retirement Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 12 of Chapter 11 is hereby amended by inserting after the words “general court”  
2 the words: “including any person, corporation, association, trust, partnership, the MBTA  
3 Retirement Fund, or other legal entity which receives or expends public funds for the payment or  
4 administration of pensions as defined in section 1 of chapter 32 for any current or former  
5 employees of the commonwealth, any constituent unit or any political subdivision thereof.
