An Act relative to solar energy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1A of Chapter 164 as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is  
2 hereby amended in clause (f) by striking out in the first sentence the figure “35” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following figure “1000”.

4           Said clause is further amended by striking in the first sentence the words “December 31,  
5 2016 and are constructed prior to December 31, 2017” and inserting in place thereof the words:-  
6 “December 31, 2020, and are constructed by December 31, 2030.”
