An Act relative to the cultural council grant provision requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 54 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following:-

3           Notwithstanding any rules or regulations to the contrary, the council shall require any  
4 organization applying for a grant through which the council reviews, to disclose any monies  
5 accepted directly or indirectly from a foreign body outside of the United States of America.
