The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act providing for the board of library commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. To provide for a program of capital facility repairs and improvements to 2 protect and improve the capital facilities of the commonwealth and for a program of capital asset 3 acquisitions for general government operations, the sums set forth in sections 2, 2A, 2B and 2C, 4 inclusive, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this act are hereby 5 made available, subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public funds, which sums shall 6 be in addition to any other amounts previously appropriated for these purposes; provided, 7 however, that the amounts specified for a particular project may be adjusted in order to facilitate 8 projects authorized in this act.

SECTION 3. To meet the expenditures necessary in carrying out section 2, the state treasurer shall, upon request of the governor, issue and sell bonds of the commonwealth in an amount to be specified by the governor from, time to time, but not exceeding, in the aggregate, \$151,200,000. All such bonds issued by the commonwealth shall be designated on their face, Capital Improvement Act of 2018, and shall be issued for a maximum term of years, not exceeding 30 years, as the governor may recommend to the general court pursuant to section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution. The bonds shall be payable not later than June 30, 2052. All interest and payments on account of principal on these obligations shall be payable from the General Fund. Bonds and interest thereon issued pursuant to this section shall, notwithstanding any other provision of this act, be general obligations of the commonwealth.
