In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to autonomous vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 19L the
- 2 following new section:-
- 3 Section 19M
- 4 An autonomous vehicle registered in this state must continue to meet federal standards
- 5 and regulations for a motor vehicle. The vehicles shall not be engaged in the transport of
- 6 interstate commerce or the transporting of eight or more people and or goods for hire unless a
- 7 human operator is present in the autonomous vehicle such that he or she has the ability to
- 8 monitor the vehicles performance and intervene, if necessary.
