An Act relative to drivers licenses for international students.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1.

2 An international student, who is at least 18 years old, with an F-1 visa from one of the  
3 countries in Appendix “C” of the RMV regulations, who has obtained their Massachusetts  
4 drivers permit, may continue to legally drive on the roads of the Commonwealth on his or her  
5 own country’s valid license for an additional 45 days following the date on which they received  
6 their Massachusetts driving permit.
