**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court

An Act relative to funeral processions and fines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14A of chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting in subsection (d) (4) at the end thereof the following :-"violations of sections (1)
3 through (4) of subsection (d) shall be punishable by a fine of fifty dollars."

4 SECTION 2. Section 42 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
