In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to toll discounts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
2	is hereby amended by inserting after section 17C the following new section:-
3	Section 17D. There shall be a twenty five per cent reduction in tolls charged for drivers in
4	electric vehicles, as defined in Section 16 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, driving on the
5	Massachusetts Turnpike, the Tobin Bridge and/or the Ted Williams Tunnel. The driver of an
6	electric vehicle is only allowed to apply the reduction to one passenger vehicle, which the driver
7	must own or rent. There shall be no application fee for a driver to apply and be approved for said
8	reduction.
9	Any person who receives the reduction and allows an unauthorized driver to utilize said
10	reduction shall be fined \$50 for the first violation, \$100 for the second violation, and \$150 for
11	the third and all subsequent violations. In addition to the fine for the third violation, the driver's
12	authorization to receive a reduction shall be revoked permanently. The executive office of

- 13 transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of this section
- 14 within the existing toll collection system.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
