By Mr. Wong of Saugus, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3190) of Donald H. Wong and others for an investigation by a commission (including members of the General Court) relative to extending the Blue Line to the city of Lynn. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the extension of the blue line.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special laws to the contrary, there
2 shall be a commission to study the financial feasibility and department capability of extending
3 the MBTA blue line to include a stop in Lynn. The commission shall consist of 8 members: 2
4 members of the house of representatives, 1 of whom shall be appointed by the house minority
5 leader; 2 members of the senate, 1 of whom shall be appointed by the senate minority leader; the
6 secretary of the department of transportation or a designee; the chairman of the MBTA or a
7 designee, and 2 members to be appointed by the governor.

8 SECTION 2. The commission shall file its findings and recommendations with the chairs
9 of the joint committee on transportation no later than six months following the passage of this
10 bill.
