An Act relative to veterans with post-traumatic stress.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 276A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, inserted by section 35 of chapter 218 of the acts of 2018, is hereby amended in  
3 subsection (c) by inserting after the words “substance abuse disorder” the following: — “, post-  
4 traumatic stress”
