## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to forfeiture.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- 3 "Provided however, if the amount of marijuana recovered or seized is ten pounds or
- 4 more, then the marijuana accessories shall be subject to forfeiture by the Commonwealth
- 5 pursuant to section 47 of chapter 94C."
