**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act to enhance driver impairment prevention.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in paragraph 4,. after the words “the
3 incarceration and rehabilitation of drinking drivers.” the following language. “The defendant
4 during incarceration shall undergo an assessment that uses a standardized evidence-based
5 instrument performed by a provider or other licensed or certified substance use disorder
6 professional to determine whether he or she has a diagnosis for alcohol dependence and would
7 likely benefit from a United States Food and Drug Administration approved medication-assisted
8 treatment that is indicated for the treatment of alcohol dependence.”
