An Act relative to protective orders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 43A of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as  
2   appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           Notwithstanding the provisions of any other general or special law to the contrary, any  
4   person suffering from the willful and malicious conduct of another, as described in this section or  
5   section 43 may file a complaint in the court requesting protection from such abuse.
