An Act relative to expungement of youth criminal records.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 100I of chapter 276, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
2 out clause (4) and inserting in place thereof the following clause:-

3 (4) other than motor vehicle offenses in which the penalty does not exceed a fine of \$50  
4 and the offense that is the subject of the petition to expunge, the petitioner has not more than 3  
5 other criminal court appearances, juvenile court appearances or dispositions on file with the  
6 commissioner;
